The said action being appeals from the action of the board of county commissioners of said Sargent County in the allowance of bills against said county. The said case in which L. O. Babcock is plaintiff now having been transferred to Stutsman County for trial and determination on a change of venue and Resolved that E. W. Thorpe State Attorney of Sargent <sup>County</sup> and is hereby substituted as attorney for the county in all of said cases. On motion board adjourned Sine Die.
