

Session December 4th 1883.

A petition was presented signed by P. M. Chandler presenter and twelve residents of the Town of Milnor praying for the location of two public highways as follows.

To the Board of Co^{rs} Comm^{rs} of Sargent Co. D.T.

We the undersigned residents of the Town of Milnor and Vicinity in said County would respectfully petition your Hon^{ble} body to locate Public Highways upon the following routes, To wit Commencing at the center of the south west end of 3rd Avenue Milnor running thence on the best ground for a public highway until it intersects the section line at or near the south west corner of section Sixteen in T. 132. R. 54. Also commencing at or near the south east corner of said section Sixteen running thence south westerly on the best ground for a public highway until it intersects the road above petitioned for. somewhere south of the slough which is near the north line of said Section Sixteen

On motion A. F. Price P. M. Chandler and Charles Afdem were appointed Road Viewers to examine said proposed routes and report to the board at their next Meeting

Session January 10th 1884.

The following Petition was presented to the board.

To the Honorable Board of Commissioners of Sargent County D.T.

We the undersigned citizens of said County respectfully represent that the public convenience and safety requires the erection and maintenance of a bridge across the stream known as the Wild Rice. We believe said bridge should be built somewhere in the vicinity of the Sprague Lake and they further pray that you take such steps as will secure the erection of one as early as practicable Signed &c.

Upon full consideration of the above petition it is hereby ordered by this board that William G. Sprague Peter Brougher and J. S. Gray be appointed a Committee to locate the place of building said bridge and make full and complete specifications of the bridge necessary to be built giving the amount and kind of material to be used and an estimate of its cost and report at our next session

Session January 11th 1884.

Albert J. Price and P. M. Chandler viewers appointed at the session of December 4th 1883 to view certain routes for highways in sections 9 and 16 Township 132. Range 54. presented their report. Said report was accepted and adopted. and the highways therein described are hereby declared public Highways. On motion said report was ordered to be spread upon the records. and is as follows.
