Resolved, That the states attorney be and is hereby requested to report in writing to this board at their next meeting, the present condition in court; what, if anything, has been done by him to prepare and bring to trial the suits of H. Justice Report

Justice report of B. F. Grimes for quarter ending Jan. 5, 1892, was presented and on motion approved.

Voting precinct Changed

Moved by Patterson that the voting place of Sargent precinct be changed from Sargent school house No. 1, to Pattersons Hall, in the village of Bogswell. Seconded and carried.

Money appropriated for defraying expenses of teachers institute

On motion \$30 was appropriated out of the county general fund for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the teachers institute.

Auditor was instructed to draw a warrant for said amount in favor of D. J. McKinzie, county superintendent.

Places designated for Sale of Chattle

The following places were designated for the sale of chattle for the year 1892: at the front door of the post office in the following places:

Stratville, Bogswell, Dearlem, Havana, Rutland, Summers, Ransom De Larnu, Nicholson and Milnor, at the front door of the courthouse in the town of Forman.

At the front door of the Forby post office, in White Stone Hill twp.

Petition laid over.

On motion the petition asking the county to lay a sidewalk, was laid over till the next meeting of the board.

Money transferred to Gen. Co. fund

On motion \$800 of the balance on hand April 1, 1892 in the road and bridge fund and \$1000 of the balance on hand in the poor fund was ordered transferred to the general county fund.

Warrant drawn to satisfy judgment against County

On motion the auditor was instructed to draw a warrant in favor of E. W. Thayer for the purpose of satisfying a judgment held against the county by Van Bunt and Davison, in the amount of \$108.34.
