Board of Justice Bond of Ole F. Johnson, justice of the peace, as principal, and John Est and M. J. Askirvorn as sureties, was presented and on motion approved. On motion the register of deeds was allowed one clerk and the sum of \$600 per year for clerk hire, and the county auditor was allowed one clerk and \$600. per year as clerk hire. On motion the treasurer was allowed one clerk and \$400 per year as clerk hire.
