Notice to destroy Russian Thistle ordered published

The following notice was ordered published viz "Notice is hereby given that in compliance with Sec 1 Chap. 91 Session Laws of 1891, every person and every Corporation shall destroy upon all lands owned by any such person or Corporation, all weeds of the kinds known as Canada thistle, Cockle bur, mustard, wild oats, French weed and Russian Cactus, between the 20th day of May and the 10th day of June 1893. In case any person or Corporation owning or occupying any lands as above mentioned neglects or refuses to comply with provisions of the above named act, the Road Overseer, or Supervisors of the respective Civil townships of the County shall, after the expiration of ten days after the said 10th day of June 1893, forthwith destroy such weeds in such manner as shall effectually prevent such weeds from growing into seed.
