And it appearing to the satisfaction of this Board, and Superintendent, that threefourths of the resident voters in and of the parts of the districts to be included in such new district and parts of district desiring such change, have signed such petition, and that there are at least twelve children of school age within the boundaries proposed to be benefitted by such change and creation of such new district; and it further appearing to the satisfaction of this Board and the said Superintendent that such change will be beneficial to the schools and the public;

Resolved, That the following described land and real estate in the County of Sargent, and state of North Dakota be changed into, and be constituted, and is hereby constituted, a new school district, to wit; E $\frac{1}{2}$ of sec 24, N E $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec 25, T 13^s. R 55, also the W $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec 19, and N.W $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec 30, T 13^s. R 54; and

Further Resolved, That the said territory and new school district shall be known and designated as, and the name thereof shall be School District No Two, of Sargent County and state of North Dakota.
