

Equalization by the County Board.

Forman, N.D. July 6th 1896.

The Board of County Commissioners convened in regular session according to law. The board was called to order by A. A. Friestop chairman. All members were found to be present.

County Auditor W. N. Carlblom administered the following oath of office to the members of the board:

On motion of Mr. Smith the board proceeded to equalize, consider and correct the several assessment rolls according to law.

On motion of Mr. Hendricks, the assessment of two rows of Robert Wepfer in the town of Forman was stricken from the assessment roll of said town, the said property having been assessed in Rutland township.

On motion of Mr. Doyle, the assessment of W. W. Bradley in Rutland township was corrected and changed to Forman Telephone Company.

On motion of Mr. Smith the assessment of the Forman Telephone Company was reduced as follows: Custer township from \$19. to \$15.; Milnor from \$50 to \$40; Ransom from \$90 to \$64; Rutland from \$25. to \$3.; Sargent from \$50. to \$6 and in the town of Milnor from \$20 to \$10. On motion the board adjourned to 9 o'clock a.m. July 7, 1896.

Second Day.

July 7, 1896, 9 a.m.

The board convened pursuant to adjournment, Mr. Friestop in the chair. All members present. Minutes of the meeting July 6th were on motion approved.

On motion of Mr. Smith the assessment on 6 1/2 of lots 10, 11 + 12, in block 2, town of Forman was reduced from \$360 to \$300.

On motion of Mr. Smith the assessment of Lawler + Arnold Lumber Company, at Forman, was reduced from \$1,000 to \$900.

On motion of Mr. Johnson, the board adjourned to 1 o'clock p.m.
