Resolution regarding real estate valuation

Whereas, It appearing to the Board of County Commissioners of Sargent County North Dakota, that the real estate in said county has greatly depreciated in value the past few years, and that heretofore the same has been assessed for a larger sum than its actual cash value; that it is now returned by this board at its full value; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, That we respectfully request the Honorable State Board of Equalization not to increase the value of said as returned by this board; that it would be a manifest injustice and hardship upon the owners of said lands to have the valuation thereof increased. Be it further

Resolved, That the County Auditor be instructed to transmit a copy of this resolution to the Honorable State Board of Equalization.
