in Herman Mr. Friskop reported in the matter of washed out bridges in Herman township as follows:  
Three bridges entirely gone and one in dangerous condition, and recommended that all bridges be replaced new and that the bridge across the Wild Rice between sections 11 and 14 be repaired.

Herman Twp. The following resolution was introduced and on motion adopted.  
Be it Resolved, that the county auditor be and he is hereby instructed to forthwith advertise for bids for the construction of two bridges in Herman township at the following places:  
Between sections 2 and 35 on the town line between Hall and Herman  
Between sections 31 and 36 on the town line between Shuman and Herman  
According to the approved plans and specifications now on file in the auditor's office.

for repairing  
bridges, Herman On motion \$75.00 was appropriated out of the road and bridge fund for material to be used in repairing the bridge across the Wild Rice between sections 11 and 14 in Herman township and A. A. Friskop was appointed a committee to have the said bridge repaired and disburse said amount.

bridge, Hall Mr. Friskop moved that an appropriation of \$50.00 be made out of the road and bridge fund for the repairing of a bridge in Hall township between sections 25 and 26, across the Wild Rice river.

Taylor Twp. Petition from residents of Taylor township for the building of two bridges across the Wild Rice river was presented and on motion M. Doyle was appointed a committee to view the sites and make estimate of said proposed bridges and report at the next session of the board.
