

## Regular meeting, January 1902

Forman, N. D., Jan 6<sup>th</sup> 1902

- Jan 6<sup>th</sup> 1902 The Board of County Commissioners of Sargent County, N. D. met at the office of the county auditor pursuant to law. Present Messrs Johnson, Stevens and Lund.
- Vacancies existing in the office of County Commissioner for the first and fourth districts; the Board, pursuant to Sec 366 of the Revised Codes of 1899, met with the county judge and the county auditor, as an appointing board to fill such vacancies.
- Appointing Board County Judge J. W. Christian was chosen chairman of the appointing board and R. McCarter was chosen secretary.
- Minutes of Appointing Board Mr Johnson moved that Mr C. G. Seltrick be appointed county commissioner for the first district, which motion prevailed, all members voting "aye".
- J. W. Straub App'd 4<sup>th</sup> District Mr Lund moved that J. W. Straub be appointed commissioner for the fourth district, which motion prevailed, all members voting "aye".
- Cash of Office Adm'd Mr Stevens moved that the appointing board do now adjourn, which motion prevailed.
- Bullet for Chairman The oath of office was administered by county auditor R. McCarter to the newly elected county commissioners, C. G. Seltrick and J. W. Straub.
- Application of J. P. Williamson for reduction of tax on the Sturum flouring mill, which application was on motion rejected.
- Recess Mr Seltrick moved that the Board take a recess for thirty minutes, which motion prevailed.
- Petition of A. A. Stockstad A. A. Stockstad appeared before the Board, presenting a petition signed by ninety-four resident taxpayers, asking for an appropriation to pay for medical services rendered to Mr Stockstad.
- Appropriation for Stockstad On motion the sum of \$143.90 was appropriated out of the poor fund to pay for treatment rendered Mr Stockstad at the Stanbenson hospital.
- Taxes Abated on lots 117-12 Blk 35, Forman On motion the 1893 tax on lot 23-130-58 was ordered abated on the basis of the original tax at 7% and sheriff's fees.
- Taxes Abated on lot 15 Blk 8 Forman On motion the 1894 tax on lot 117-12 Blk 35 second addition to the town of Forman was abated to the original tax at 7% and sheriff's fees.
- On motion the offer of N. H. Dyle to pay the sum of \$20 in settlement of all delinquent taxes against lot 15 Blk 8, Town of Forman was accepted. On motion the Board adjourned at 9 o'clock a.m. Jan 7<sup>th</sup> 1902.
