Connor, on condition that Mr Connor redeem tax sale certificates for the years 1890, 1898, 1899 and 1901, and pay into the county treasury the sum of \$6.55

Mr Peterson moved that the Auditor and treasurer be authorized to accept the sum of \$40.00 and sheriff's fees, in full settlement of all taxes held by the county against lot 7, block 7, Town of Forman.

Deed ordered lots 14 & 15 blk 35 Forman

Mr Marcellus moved that the Auditor and treasurer be authorized to make settlement of all taxes held by the county against lots 14 and 15, block 35, Town of Forman, on the basis of the original tax at 7 per cent and sheriff's fees, the Auditor to issue tax deed in consideration of same, - said lots having become forfeited to the county under the provisions of the revenue laws of the state.

Deed ordered lot 16 blk 2 Coopers add to Rutland

Mr Marcellus moved that the Auditor be authorized to sell and transfer all the right, title and interest of the county in lot 16, block 2, Coopers Addition to Rutland, to Jacob Jacobson, on payment of \$35.00 and sheriff's fees, if any; same to be in full settlement of all taxes due the County.
