the furtherance of justice;

Therefore, Be it Resolved, That the Board of County Com-
missioners of Sargent County use every means, ^{with} in their
power, and under authority of law, to bring to justice the
perpetrator of the terrible crime which has been committed,
and that no time or expense be spared in the further-
ance of said object.
