Mr Petersen moved that for the purpose of equalization, the per cent of increase and decrease in the value of structures and improvements in the following assessors districts be as follows:

Willy, increase 50 per cent; Yorman, increase 50 per cent; Nansen, increase 25 per cent; Sargent, decrease 20 per cent; Town of Milnor, increase 15 per cent; Rutland, increase 33 1/3 per cent; Danvor, decrease 40 per cent; Kingslow, increase 100 per cent; Town of Forman, decrease 20 per cent; and all other districts no change.

Mr Dwyer moved that for the purpose of equalization the average value of town lots in the Town of Milnor be decreased 25 per cent.

Mr Dwyer moved that for the purpose of equalization the average value of town lots in the Town of Forman be increased 25 per cent.

Mr Marcellus moved that the assessment on block 10 Village of Havana be reduced from \$160.00 to \$100.00.

Mr Petersen moved that for the purpose of equalization, horses, 1900 & the value of horses, one year old be fixed at \$100, and the per centum of increase and decrease in the various assessors' districts be as follows:

Harlem, decrease 16 2/3 per cent; Lake, decrease 16 2/3 per cent; Jackson, increase 10 per cent; Town of Forman, increase 10 per cent; Kingslow, decrease 16 2/3 per cent.
