The agenda for the special meeting was to discuss the counteroffer from Paul and Amy Serenko in regards to their complaints of retaliation. Also in attendance were Tia Bopp, Auditor; Mark Breker, Duane Peterson, HR Director; and Jayne Pfau State's Attorney.

The Serenkos are counteroffering for \$125,000. Motion to deny the counteroffer and not to enter into mediation. (Bopp/Anderson) Upon roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

Discussion on conversations the Auditor's office and Sue Seelye had recently.

Motion to terminate Sue Seelye based on our mediation requests and past recommendations from HR effective December 31, 2025, and advertise for a new park manager. (Bopp/Johnson). Voting yes were Johnson, Bopp, Christianson, Anderson and Colemer. Voting no were Arth and Waswick. Motion carried.

Discussion regarding advertising for a new park manager. HR will be working on drafting the job description. The position is currently non-exempt. This will be a full-time position. Tia will distribute proposed job descriptions to the board once the same is available.
