Joe Breker, Havana met with the Board to discuss a drainage problem he has on his land (W1/2 and NW1/4 of SE1/4-5-129-54 LTL). He got a wetland determination with NRCS and got permission from FSA for CRP land and a verbal agreement with US F & W that they didn't have any concern on this drainage issue. He hasn't done any engineering at this time and is unsure about the outlet. He would like to install a perforated tile because it is wet all the time from seepage. An application to drain was presented to Mr. Breker and he will proceed with the process and mail to NDSWC.

The Board received an update on the Silver Lake Stabilization project. There has been a delay but this is a top priority and they are hopeful that before the end of January the work on design and planning will be complete and a draft design ready by late February. Red River Riparian Board expects to get a spring planting and complete the rock work this fall.

The Board received a letter from William E. Smith regarding the Tewaukon Watershed 2003 assessment. The Board will send Mr. Smith a response.

Quentin Hoistad stopped at the meeting to ask permission for the Sargent County Park Board to trench water away from the Silver Lake dam to eliminate the beaver dams. Approved.

The bridge that is being replaced in Denver Township 105-01 has four large concrete pillars. The commissioners contacted Dan about the Water Board taking these pillars and using it for a low water crossing in Section 14-132-58. Roger White has been working on this and the Board needs more information on cost.

Approve third Thursday of each month as regular meeting dates of the Sargent County Water Board. A copy of the meeting times is on file in the Office of the County Auditor. (Engst/Breker, unanimous)
